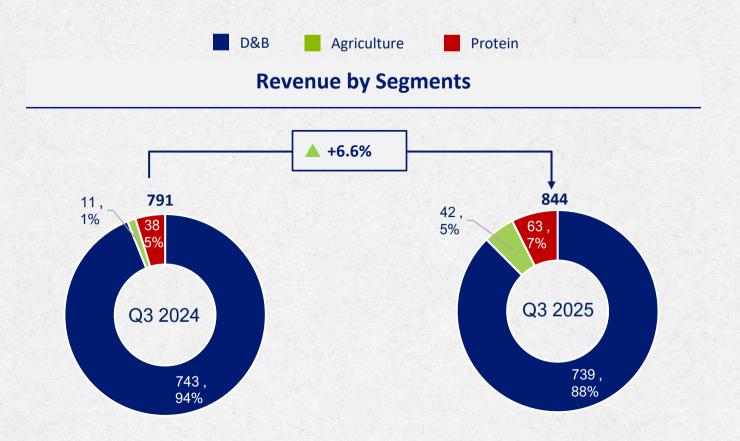

Financial Performance Q3 2025

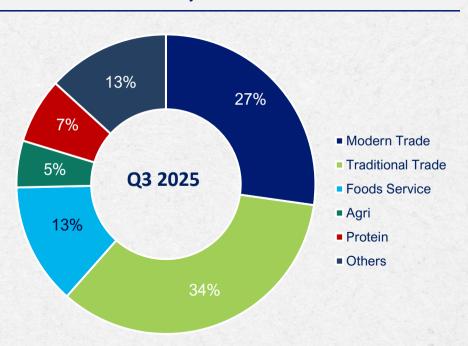

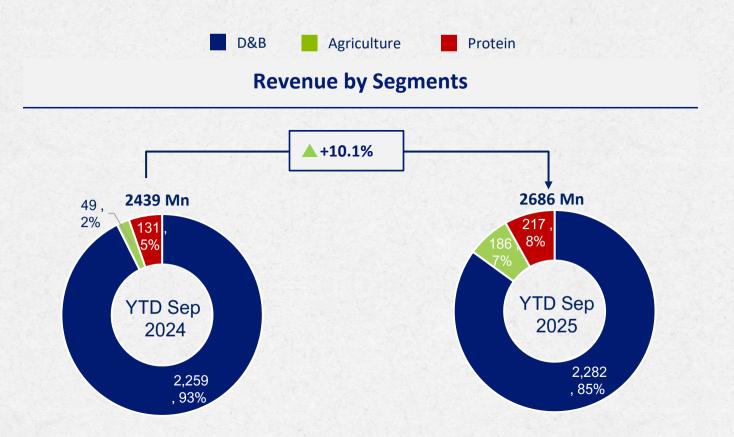

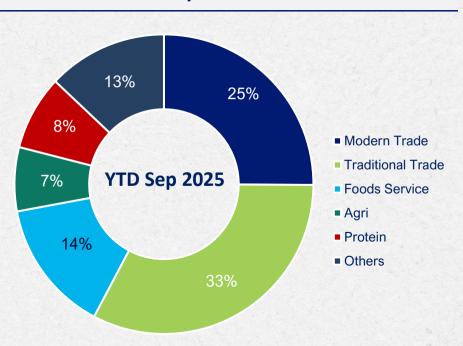

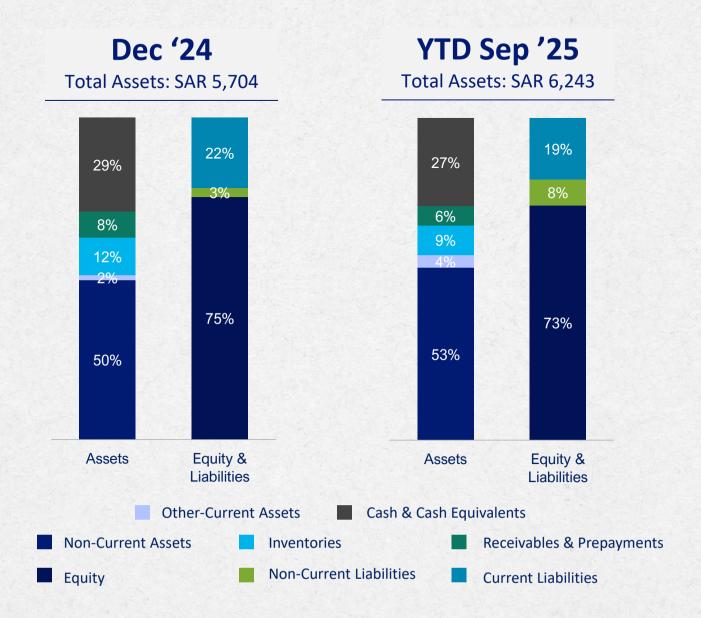


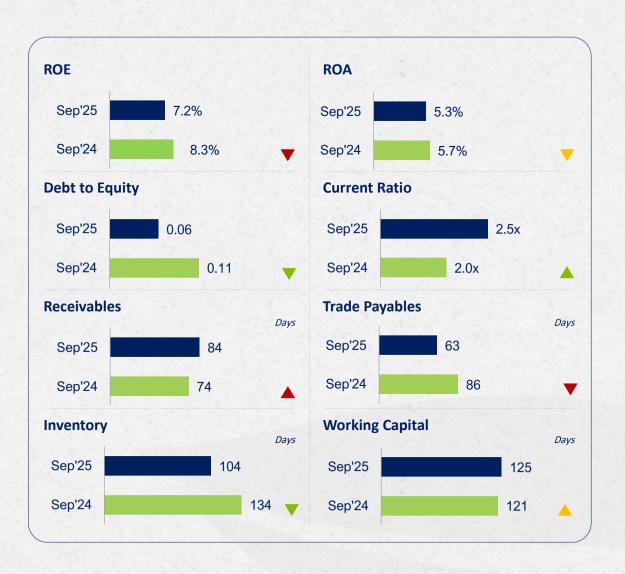

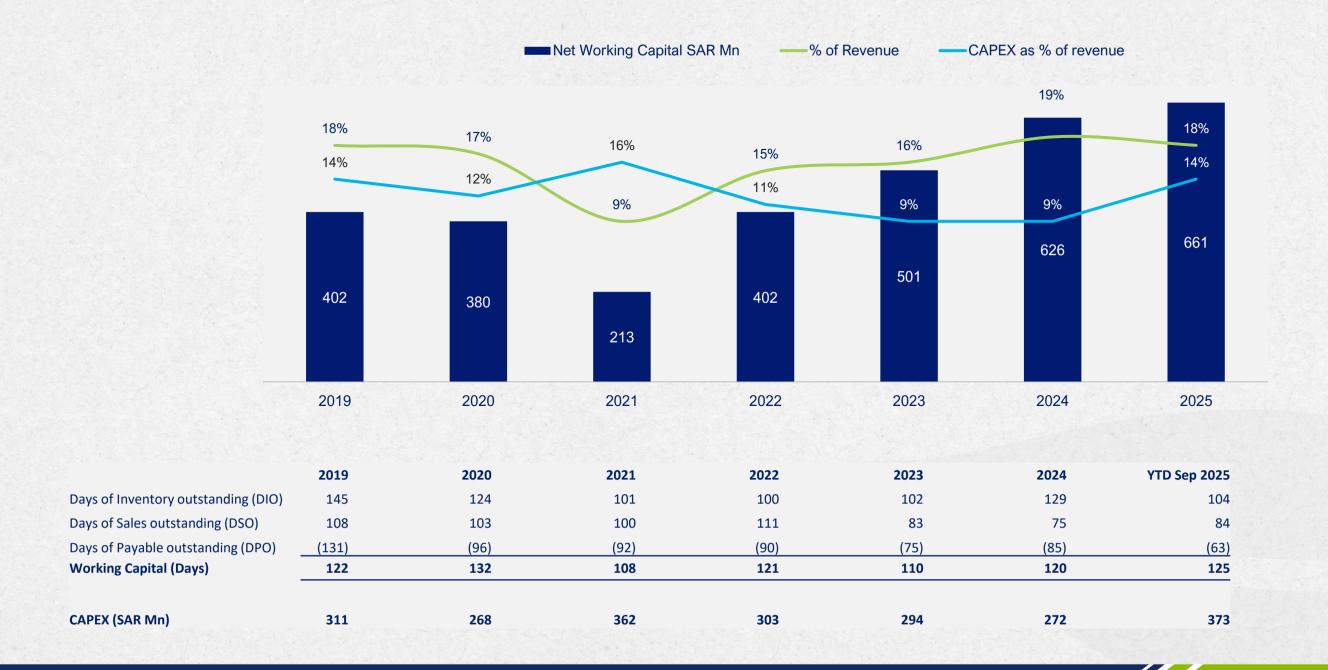
Net Income Bridge (in SAR Mn)

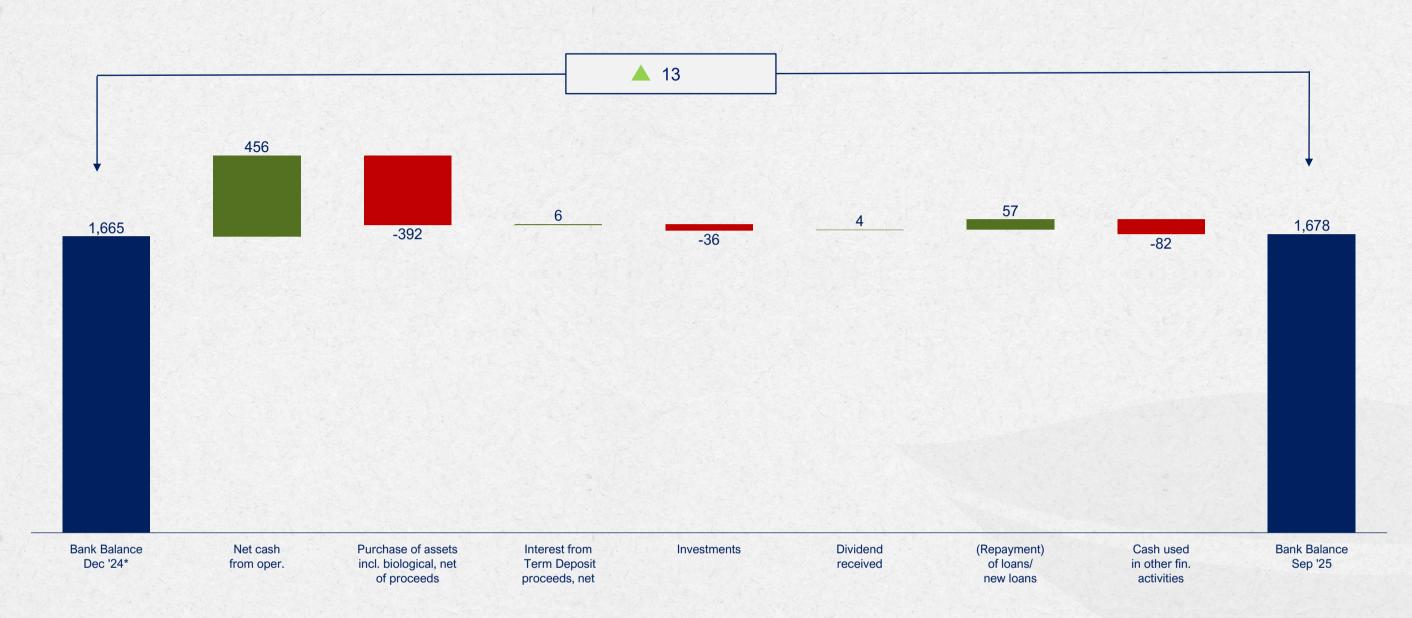




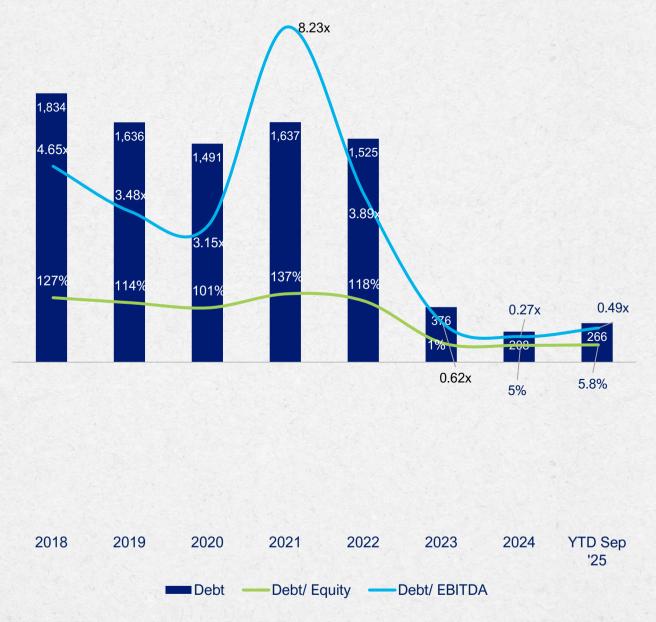


Working Capital (in SAR Mn)
